
Welcome

In the Ancient Near East many pagan and polytheistic religions had temples or sanctuaries that functioned as cultic centers for the purpose of feeding or sustaining a particular god or gods from that religions pantheon. The tabernacle of Israel, while it was a sanctuary, was vastly different. Specifically, because God himself dwelled there. There were also three other primary functions of the tabernacle of Israel.

The first was a place for him to issue commands for Israel. This role Worship @ 10:30am is made explicit in 25:22 where the LORD defines that he will "Speak... from above the mercy seat... about everything I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel." This arrangement is later demonstrated in Numbers 7:89.

The second function was that of a place of worship and sacrifice for the people of Israel. This is demonstrated in 25:30 and 29:38-42 where God defines the manner in which sacrifices are to be presented to him at the tent. The priests (Aaron and his sons) were also instructed to "minister" to God at the tabernacle in 29:44.

The final, and most important purpose of the tabernacle was for the benefit of the covenant relationship of Israel. Thanks to the intricate design and establishment of the tabernacle God's presence is available to the Israelites. This presence was essential to the covenant between God and the Hebrew people and was unique among ancient religions.


